## Our approach

### Ownership

- Integrating environmentally, socially, and economically responsible sourcing and governance factors into the projects operating and procurement processes.
- Monitoring key supply chain partners by requiring partners to periodically report against sustainability performance metrics and record compliance with project requirements.

- Where possible, procure services and materials locally to reduce transport emissions, support local businesses and provide jobs and upskilling of the local labour forces.
- Seeking compliance with all relevant laws and regulations including the Modern Slavery Act 2018, the International Labour Organization's Fundamental Contentions and the "Ten Principles" of the UN Global Compact
